As requested, we have reviewed the standard stair flight formwork lifting hooks, as detailed on your drawing titled "Crane Hook", for compliance with the requirements of the Australian Standards AS4100 & AS 1418.1.

The 30 x 3mm steel plate lifting lugs will be adequate for an 18 riser form, provided that –

- 1. The lugs are fabricated from 3mm steel plate in accordance with the drawing provided,
- 2. The lifting lugs are welded to the stair form with 3mm continuous fillet welds,
- 3. There are 4 lifting lugs per stair flight, and they are evenly loaded,
- 4. The crane lifting hook shall connected to the stair form hook using a steel shackle,
- 5. The maximum acceleration at the initial lift does not exceed 0.6 metres per second per second,
- 6. The maximum weight of the stair flight form does not exceed 450 kg.




